Pyth yw Kernewek rag book? Lyver yw. Lyver yw Kernewek rag book. Da lowr, pyth yw Kernewek rag two books? Dew lyver yw, literally 'two book' – splann we don't need to know what the plural of lyver is. There's more - pyth yw Kernewek rag lots of books? Lies lyver there's no need to know the plural, useful word lies 'lots, many.'
